Kayak preparation:

1. Dress in quick-drying clothing or bathing suit.
2. Check weather for additional apparel, e.g. windbreaker, loose fitting long-pants
3. Water shoes, full-strapped sandals w/tread or old sneakers.
4. Sunglasses, sunscreen, brimmed hat optional.
5. Water bottle, most kayaks are equipped w/cup holder.
6. Waterproof camera
7. Dry-bag or sealable plastic bag if needed for dry items or valuables.
8. Insect repellent is usually optional.
9. Cocoa Kayak's liability waiver (download/print from our website's Home page)
10. A care-free attitude.

What to expect from kayak and creek:

The sit-inside kayaks were built for recreational users. Kayak bottoms are fairly wide and flat, offering much "balance forgiveness". Foot braces and cushioned seats are adjustable. The Swatara Creek is primarily gentle and no spray skirt is required. Most creek banks are lined with trees, limestone outcrops, and a few small islands mid-stream. The water's edge has pebbled spots ideal for short breaks. Water levels are typically 1-3 feet with sporadic deep spots ideal for fishing. Great Blue Heron, and occasionally Bald Eagles, often fish the creek side, and are incredible subjects for the quick photographer.
